Tell them your opinions of the book and ask for some advice to help improve your writing in the future.</p>	<p><u>Option 3</u></p> <p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Make something to do with our current topic - Changes from the Anglo-Saxons to Ancient Greeks. It could even be a food item from this time period!</p>
<p><u>Option 4</u></p> <p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Paint your very Anglo-Saxon painting and write the story you have told within your painting.</p>	<p><u>Option 5</u></p> <p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>Ask an adult in year 4 for a maths problem solving sheet.</p>	<p><u>Option 6</u></p> <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Read a newspaper with a grown up. Make a bullet point list of the main stories and current events you have found out about.</p>
