<p><u>Option 1</u></p> <p><b>Research</b></p> <p>To research the Ancient Egyptian Gods.</p> <p>Present your work as a non-fiction text.</p>	<p><u>Option 2</u></p> <p><b>Diary</b></p> <p>Write a diary entry from the perspective of either: a Pharaoh, slave, priest or villager.</p>	<p><u>Option 3</u></p> <p><b>DT</b></p> <p>To make a model based on Ancient Egypt.</p> <p>E.g Pyramid, tombs, Sphinx, canopic jar, mummy, sarcophagus, death mask.</p>
<p><u>Option 4</u></p> <p><b>Art</b></p> <p>To recreate an Ancient Egyptian scene or themed picture.</p> <p>E.g The Nile, pyramids, inside a Pharaoh's tomb, death mask,.</p>	<p><u>Option 5</u></p> <p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>Ask an adult in year 5 for a maths problem solving sheet.</p>	<p><u>Option 6</u></p> <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Read a chapter of your book. Make a list of all vocabulary you are unfamiliar with. Find the definition of the word and then rewrite it in your own sentence.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 7</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Hieroglyphics</u></b></p> <p>Draw/write your full name in hieroglyphics.</p> <p>Then write at least 3 facts about Ancient Egypt that interest you.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 8</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>SUMDOG</u></b></p> <p>Spend some time improving your mental maths skills on <a href="http://www.sumdog.com">www.sumdog.com</a></p> <p>Ask for your login details if you have forgotten!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 9</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Pyramid builder</u></b></p> <p>Draw a floor plan of a Pharaoh's pyramid to be built. Label each room and give the measurements (length and width). Then work out the perimeter and area for each room and the total pyramid.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 10</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Film/book review</u></b></p> <p>Watch a film or read a book then write a review about it. Use subheadings and paragraphs to organise your ideas.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 11</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Ancient Egypt Timeline</u></b></p> <p>Create a timeline showing some key events during Ancient Egypt period or the life of a particular Pharaoh.</p> <p>Make sure you think about the order of the dates/years</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Option 12</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Research</u></b></p> <p>Research and create a leaflet or presentation about Ancient Egypt. Pick a minimum of 3 topics to include.</p> <p>E.G. Pharaohs, pyramids, sphinx, tombs, mummification, the Nile, daily life.</p>
